

The villagers of Oberammergau vowed that if their town was spared, they would perform the Passion of Christ every 10 years. The town was spared, and it is amazing that they have been honoring this pledge from generation to generation. The Passion Play performance follows Christ from His triumphant entry into Jerusalem through His Trial, Crucifixion, Resurrection, and Ascension.

Then, as a Grand Finale, your tour will take you on a cruise along one of Europe's most romantic rivers, you will sail through history into a world filled with a variety of amazing architecture and breathtaking scenery. Our Oberammergau Passion Play & Passau to Budapest cruise takes you on a journey of discovery into "Old Europe," uncovering ancient abbeys, beautiful palaces, historic landmarks and stunning vistas. From the villages of Melk & Passau, to the vibrant and cosmopolitan cities of Vienna, & Budapest. Your trip will highlight iconic sights and bustling city streets. You can look forward to enjoying all this from the deck of a 4 ½ star Ship!

Interesting Facts About the Oberammergau Passion Play: To be in the play, you must be a resident of Oberammergau. Over 2,000 citizens are involved including acting, singing, musicians and technical support. There are 124 speaking roles, a 65-member orchestra, 48 person chorus and hundreds of people involved in the back end including stagehands, seamstresses, firemen, auditorium attendants and more. Men grow out their hair and beards to make the look authentic to the time. Costumes are hand made. The play is held May through late September or early October. During these months, the play is performed 5 days per week in an open-air theater which seats about 4,700 people. The performance begins at 2:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. There is then a dinner break, and the play resumes from 8:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. The play is performed in German, but it doesn't seem to stop people from all over the world, including those that are not of religious backgrounds that are intrigued by the way the town comes together to perform this play. It is anticipated over 750,000 will attend in 2020. The Passion Play theatre is open, and the background of the mountains makes it an unforgettable scene.



ITINERARY (subject to change / approval from the cruise company)

Day 1 - May 19, 2020: Depart the USA: Depart Florida (MIA) for Munich, Germany. ***Other gateways available upon request.

Day 2 - May 20, 2020: Welcome to Munich. On arrival at the airport, you will be met by a Jet Vacations representative and transferred* to your hotel in Munich. Here, you will have the chance to unpack, relax in your room. Dinner at the hotel and overnight. (Dinner)

Day 3 - May 21, 2020: Munich - Dachau: After breakfast at the hotel, set out to discover Munich with your guide. Start your Munich Old Town tour and explore the medieval streets while learning about the city's fascinating history and culture. A city of many names, Munich has been called the heart of medieval Europe, the Athens of the Alps and beer capital of the world. Visit pretty Marienplatz, the central city square since the 1100s, and admire the town hall with its glockenspiel that re-enacts stories from the 16th century. Stop for photos by the Cathedral of Our Blessed Lady (Frauenkirche), Munich's iconic red-roofed cathedral that was bombed during WWII, and wander around one of city's oldest places of worship: St. Peter's Church (Peterskirche). Pass through the food market of Victuals Market (Viktualienmarkt) with its brightly colored stalls and peer in the windows of Hofbräuhaus – the must-visit beer hall while in town. Stop at the former royal palace of Bavarian monarchs, Munich Residenz, and then pass into the square of Odeonsplatz where Adolf Hitler made his first push for power during the infamous 'beer hall putsch. After lunch on your own, set out to visit the Dachau Concentration Camp, the first of its kind opened in Germany by Adolf Hitler's Nazi government in 1933, which served as a model for later concentration camps. Today, the camp is a memorial to the more than 32,000 people who died and the more than 200,000 who were imprisoned during the Nazi regime. The memorial was established as a site of memory and education in 1965, 20 years after Dachau was liberated by American troops. Dinner on your own. Overnight at your hotel in Munich. (Breakfast).

Day 4 - May 22, 2020: Munich / Oberammergau: After an early breakfast, travel on your coach towards Oberammergau town center. On the way, you will have the opportunity to participate in a picture stop at King Ludwig II's Neuschwanstein castle – also known as "Cinderella Sleeping Beauty" chateau. Enjoy an included group lunch before arrival and all afternoon Passion Play experience. Dinner and overnight at your hotel in Oberammergau. (Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner)

Day 5 – May 23, 2020: Oberammergau / Passau (Embarkation). After breakfast, transfer by coach to your ship moored in Passau. After comfortably settling into your cabins, you have a special invitation to a Cocktail Reception where you will meet the crew and the captain, and acquaint yourself with life on the river. Tonight, begin cruising towards the beautiful region of Engelhartszell. (Breakfast, Welcome Dinner)

Day 6 - May 24, 2020: Passau / Melk / Dürnstein / Vienna: In the morning, set sail to Melk Abbey, the famous 900-year old Benedictine Abbey, one of Europe's largest baroque monasteries, located above the town on a splendid rocky outcrop, overlooking where the Danube joins the picturesque Wachau Valley. Melk Abbey boasts the finest Italian architecture, elaborate gold leaf walls, a 640-foot Imperial Corridor and fabulous fresco ceilings. Enjoy some free time exploring the picturesque village of Dürnstein and its Baroque-style church and where you'll spot the ruins of the castle where Richard the Lionheart, King of England, was imprisoned in 1192. In the afternoon, sail towards Vienna, known as 'The City of Music' because of its musical legacy and also regarded as 'The City of Dreams' as it was home to Sigmund Freud, the world's first psychoanalyst. After dinner on the ship, you may join our Vienna by night excursion or you may also book an optional Viennese concert. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 7 - May 25, 2020: Vienna: Austria's vibrant city of Vienna is a fantastic fusion of old and new. Today, we take you on an icon-filled tour along the Ringstrasse where you will see Vienna's world-famous Konzerthause House with a backstage visit of the concert hall. Visit the Schönbrunn Palace – Empress Sisi's former summer residence - featuring an enchanting park, zoo and labyrinth. After the tour, enjoy a steaming cup of Vienna coffee and a delicious pastry. In the afternoon, visit Vienna on your own. This evening, you have a special invitation to the Captain's Gala Dinner, where you will join your fellow travelers. (Breakfast, Lunch, Captain's Gala Dinner)

Day 8 - May 26, 2020: Bratislava / Budapest: In the morning, you will experience the bustling pedestrian plazas and stylish street cafés of Bratislava. And for a more profound insight, you will tour Old Town, home to a plethora of historical buildings. Highlights will include the including the Old Town Hall, the stunning Mirbach Palace and Gothic St. Martin's Cathedral. Here, you will also find Bratislava's Town Hall, a complex of three buildings erected in the 14th and 15th centuries, Michael's Gate, one of the oldest of the town's structures, and nearby, the narrowest house in Europe. Spend the afternoon cruising to Budapest. As you glide down the beautiful Danube, you will have a chance to see Budapest landmarks such as Parliament Building. Widely known as one of the continent's most beautiful and cosmopolitan cities, Budapest is home to many UNESCO World Heritage Sites, including the Buda Castle Quarter, Andrássy Avenue, Heroes' Square and the Millennium Underground Railway – the second oldest railway in the world. After dinner on the ship, you may join our Budapest by night excursion. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 9 - May 27, 2020: Budapest: Today, your private guided tour takes you past the Royal Palace of Buda –home to the Hungarian National Gallery, Budapest History Museum, the National Library, Lion Courtyard, Matthias Well, and the statue of the Turul Bird, the mythological bird of the Magyars. The tour then continues to Fisherman's Bastion, situated on Castle Hill, where you can admire the most breathtaking panoramic views of the city, before moving on to see Matthias Church and the iconic Chain Bridge. As one of Budapest's most symbolic landmarks, the Chain Bridge designed by English engineer William Tierney Clark, links Buda and Pest, and was considered one of the world's engineering marvels at the time of construction. Enjoy your last dinner onboard. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 10 - May 28, 2020: Departure day: After breakfast, pick up at your ship and transfer to the Budapest airport for your flight back to the US. (Breakfast)

OPTIONAL SALZBURG 2 NIGHT PRE-TOUR

Day 1: May 17, 2020 - Depart the U. S. for Munich, Austria.

Day 2: May 18, 2020 – Transfer from Munich - Altoetting to Salzburg. Welcome to Munich. Upon arrival, proceed to baggage claim and after clearing customs, look for your guide who will be holding a Jet Vacations sign at the exit. Board your deluxe coach and transfer to Salzburg. Driving through the heart of Bavaria, arrive to the town of Altoetting. It is often called the "Lourdes of Germany" due to the thousands of pilgrims who come here every year in search of healing. The shrine's reputation began in 1489 when a 3-year old child drowned in a nearby pond. Her mother rushed the dead body to the altar where a statue of Our Lady (the Black Madonna) stood. As the mother pleaded for his life to be returned to him, he opened his eyes and was restored to life. In 1980 Pope John Paul II made a pilgrimage here. A young Joseph Ratzinger came here with his father when growing up and it is known to be one of his favorite shrines long before he became Pope or even a Cardinal. Continue your journey to Salzburg. In the evening, we will gather for a welcome dinner at the hotel or in a nearby local restaurant. Overnight in Salzburg. (D)

Day 3: May 19, 2020 – Salzburg Sound of Music Tour - optional castle dinner & Mozart concert: Breakfast at the hotel. Today, relive your favorite scenes from the classic musical on The Original Sound of Music Tour in Salzburg. This comprehensive adventure takes you to the film's iconic sites around the city while providing historical background on Salzburg's top attractions and architectural jewels. Meet your guide at the hotel and hop aboard your coach. Take off through the city, with the film's soundtrack playing to set the mood. Sing along with the lyrics to 'Edelweiss,' 'Do-Re-Mi' and 'My Favorite Things' as you pass famous locations featured in the film.

- Mirabell Gardens site laid out in the 18th century where Maria and the children were seen dancing around the statue of Pegasus, the winged horse, and throughout the gardens singing 'Do-Re-Mi.'
- Leopoldskron Castle The front side of the castle was used as the Trapp family home, the children were boating on the Leopoldskron Lake and fell into the water. The Venetian room was copied from the castle and used as the ballroom.
- Hellbrunn Castle This hunting castle was built in the early 17th century by Prince-Archbishop Markus Sittikus. In the gardens the glass pavilion was reconstructed for the pleasure of those fans still returning after 30 years.
- Nonnberg Abbey the oldest convent in the German speaking part of Europe. Maria was a novice there. The baron and Maria were married here in 1927. The scenes for the movie made here include the opening with the nuns going to Mass and Maria coming too late.
- St Gilgen and Lake Wolfgang Scenery shown at the beginning of the movie was filmed at Lake Fuschl on the way to St Gilgen. Like the Mozart family, you will appreciate the beautiful village in the Salzkammergut.
- Wedding Church Mondsee Cathedral. Continue to the charming town of Mondsee, where you will have free time to explore the setting of the film's wedding at the Mondsee Cathedral which was used as the location for Maria and the Baron's wedding in the film. Wander the streets at your leisure, stopping for a delicious slice of crisp apple strudel or perusing the local shops...

Transfer back to your hotel. In the evening, join an **optional**, unique and distinctive experience in Salzburg with a **romantic dinner** in the Panorama Restaurant on the 900 year-old Salzburg Fortress (Festung Hohensalzburg), followed by a **Mozart Orchestra Concert** in the Golden Hall (or Opera Performance), with an unforgettable view of the town and province. The Mozart Chamber Orchestra of Salzburg, a chamber orchestra deeply rooted in tradition, plays with a varying line-up and also performs at international, world-renowned festivals. Mozart's most beloved works such as "A Little Night Music" as well as other treasures from the masters of music are specially performed by internationally-renowned soloists. Lunch and dinner on your own and overnight at your hotel. (B)

Day 4: May 20, 2020 – Transfer from Salzburg – Werfen – Zell Am to Munich: After breakfast, pick up at your hotel and transfer to Munich. On the way, tour the castle of Werfen dating from the 11th century. Then continue on to discover the beauty of the Hohe Tauern National Park. Loved for its lands cape of lakes and mountains, the park is home to some of Austria's most stunning scenery including the alpine village of Zell Am See. Explore the village on your own, perhaps cruising around the lake. After lunch on your own, continue on by deluxe coach to your hotel in Munich. Dinner on your own and overnight at your hotel in Munich. (B).

Specific seat requests are subject to availability at airport check-in only or passengers may contact the airlines for individual specific seating once tickets have been issued. Passenger "Record locators" are assigned by the airlines once the airlines has ticketed each passengers from the group block. This usually occurs between 60 to 30 days prior the departure date. After the airlines have assigned each traveler a "record locator", travelers may contact the airlines directly to discuss his or her seat preference. Airlines may impose additional fees for specific seats.

Cancellation Policies: No charges other than the non-refundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 180 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. However, services which have been prepaid by Jet Vacations LLC on behalf of individual clients maybe non-refundable, non-exchangeable, non changeable and/or maybe subject to a cancellation- change fee (e.g. theater tickets, Train tickets, Airline Tickets, Event Tickets, Passes, Entrance

<u>Full cancellation:</u> Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to immediately pay the outstanding balance. Payment shall then be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its

obligations, cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows: Initial deposit**: non-refundable.

From 180 to 91 days prior departure: 35% penalty of the total cost per person. From 90 to 61 days prior departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person. From 60 to 31 days prior departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person. From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the total cost per person.

** Deposit to hold the space and First deposit is non-refundable. If a passenger cancellation creates a change in the price schedule, the tour price will be revised based on the remaining number of participants. A passenger becoming a single as a result of a partner's cancellation must pay the single supplement.

NOTE: The following non-refundable fees will be added to the penalty charges listed on the cancellation (full or partial) schedule above: Travel protection premiums. Airline tickets - airline penalties, which may be up to 100% of the ticket value. Refundable airline tickets will be processed once the original paper tickets (if applicable) are returned to us via a traceable method of mailing. E-tickets do not need to be returned. Lost paper tickets have no refund value.

<u>Travel protection plan</u>: The Travel Protection Plan may not be purchased after final payment has been made. Insurance premium has to be purchased within 5 days of booking. You understand that the travel insurance is provided by a third party and that all claims will have to be addressed directly with the Travel Insurance Provider.

<u>Itinerary variation</u>: We will make every effort to operate all tours as advertised. Situations may arise, voluntarily or involuntarily, that require changes or exceptions in the airport of departure, the itinerary, land arrangements, hotels, trains or ports of call. On these occasions, we reserve the right to make such modifications and substitute conveyances/hotels as deemed necessary.

Minimum participants to Operate: Group needs a minimum of 20 participants to operate. Optional tours need a minimum of 15 participants to operate.

Tour Cancelation: We reserve the right to cancel the entire trip (or any component

of the trip) for any reason and/or time. In this event, our liability, if any, shall be limited to and liquidated by refunding to each prospective participant the payments made.

Cruise line - Hotel selection: It is the responsibility of client to ensure that the cruise line - hotels and venues that are suggested and selected in this proposal are adequate for their clientele. Jet Vacations LLC cannot and will not be responsible for cabin / room sizes, air condition, amenities, service which vary and differs throughout the world, countries, cultures and cruise lines / hotels. We strongly advise client to peruse cruise ship / hotel rating web sites such as Tripadvisor.com to get an approximate "feel" and "judgment" on each suggested and selected properties, to insure that selected cruise line /hotels cabins or rooms will be adequate to the client's group travelers. Client understand that no refund nor legal claims regarding the selected

cruise line / hotels, venues, cabins, rooms and/or services will be possible once this contract has been signed and agreed upon.

Cruise ships / Hotels Check-in times: Cruise ships cabins / hotel rooms are usually not ready for check-in until after 3 pm. If your flight is arriving early, especially European flights, you should plan for the day's activity until your room is available. Most cruise lines / hotels will store your luggage until your cabin / room is ready. Cruise lines - Hotels Air Conditioning and other amenities: Jet Vacations LLC is not responsible for air conditioning standard sor availability, as these factors can vary

greatly between properties and countries. Some hotel amenities/facilities are seasonal such as swimming pools, terraces, rooftops etc. and may not be opened or hotels may have renovations during the course of the year. Jet Vacations will not be responsible for hotel renovations, noise and/or closure of certain hotel area – facilities. tems.not.included: Jet Vacations LLC programs do not include items of a personal nature such as laundry, hotel extras, Spa or wellness centers, telephone or Wi-Ficharges and drinks with meals (unless otherwise stated in a proposal). All passengers are responsible for settling such accounts before checking out of each hotel. Hotels, Airport and airline taxes and fees are not included unless specified.

Travel Documents: Travel documents will be sent approximately 2 weeks prior to departure, providing full payment has been received. Jet Vacations LLC is not responsible for lost or stolen documents; therefore, any re-issuance of documents may be assessed their full face value and may include increase in cost. A special handling fee of \$35 will be assessed to bookings that require overnight express delivery. Some trip documents are sent as E-Documents by email. For all trip documents, it is your responsibility to check the accuracy of your airline tickets and all other documents. You are responsible to ensure that your full, official name is provided to us at the time of booking, exactly as it appears on your valid passport. It can cost up to \$250 or more per person for a name change or other ticket adjustments, plus any fare increase if applicable, due to re-ticketing.
