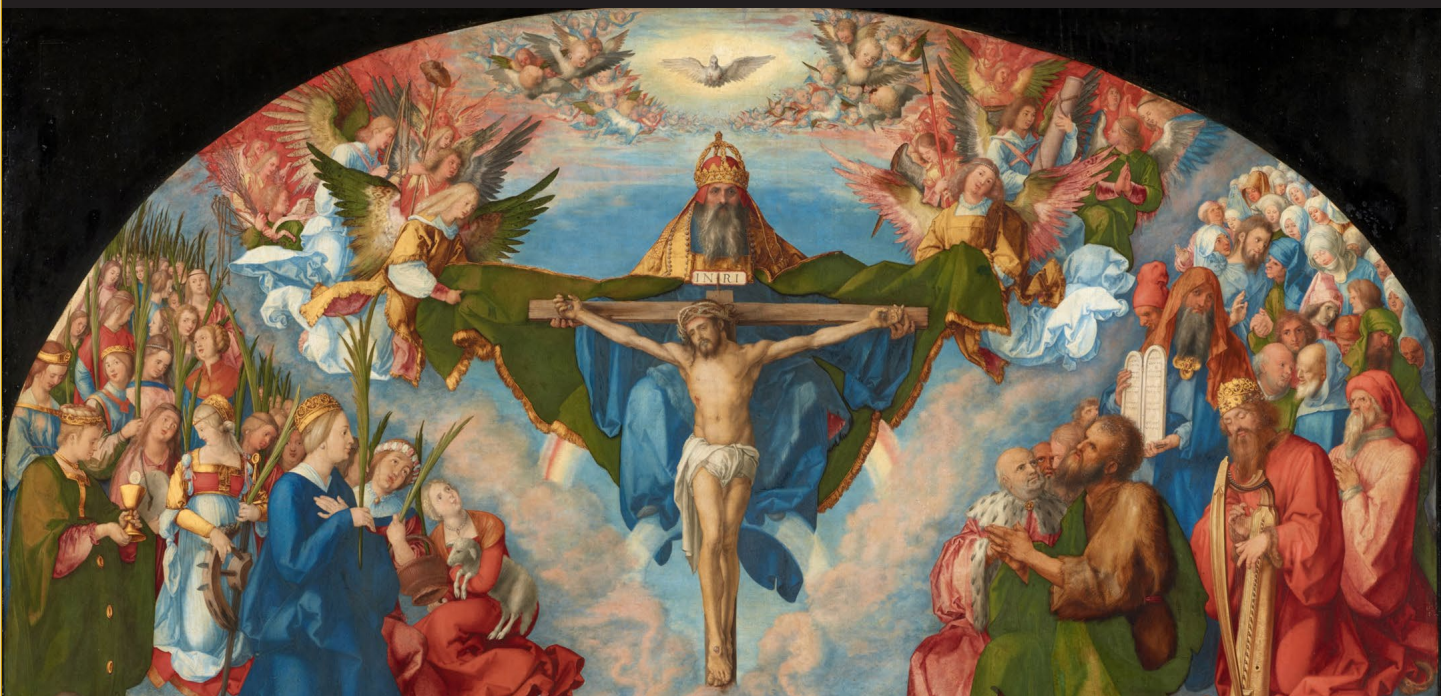

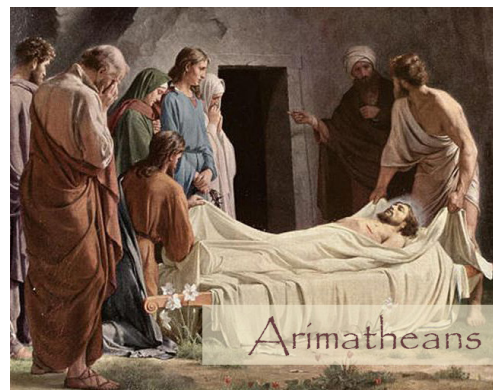
### THE HOMEBOUND MINISTRY NEEDS YOUR HELP!!!

Holy Spirit, now and forever and ever. Amen.

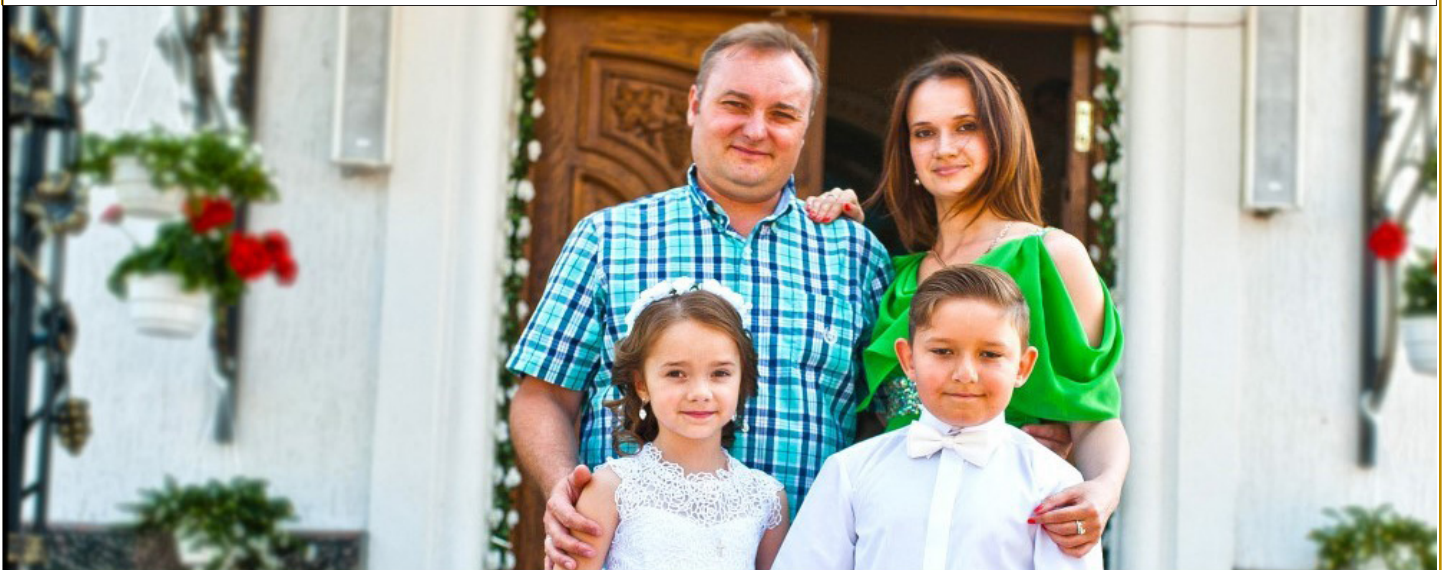
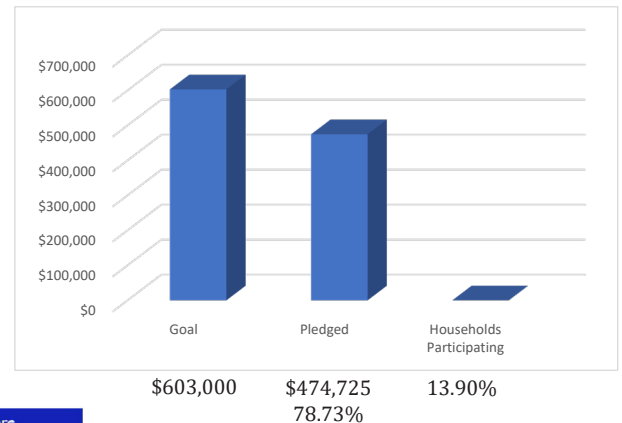
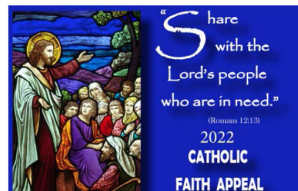


# CFA 2022

## WAYS TO GIVE

Pledging your gift may allow you to make a more generous and affordable contribution to the CFA. The pledge can be spread out over several months. You may pledge with an initial payment while the remaining balance can be donated at any time during the next nine months. The Diocese will send you monthly reminders.

**IRA:** If you are over the age of 70 1/2, you may donate up to \$100,000 per year from your Individual Retirement Account tax free to a charitable cause.
