SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Students are eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at the end of 10th grade. They must be at least 15 years old.

- 5. I understand that the school/parish/Diocesan entity youth programs may include sports (football, swimming, wrestling, etc.) and/or other risky activities (rafting, etc.).
